



President's Message

WE DID IT! Tannery Pond Center entered a long-term lease partnership with the Town of Johnsborg on December 14, 2023; a goal we had been working towards since 2021. Much of our internal work in 2023 revolved around the preparation and strengthening of our infrastructure including money and donor management systems, policies, procedures, and staffing to assure a smooth transition to the operational control of this unique Arts and Community center.

Our three programming committees, Gallery, Performance, and Events, have continued to offer a variety of free and ticketed programs to meet the diverse interests of our guests. In 2023, Tannery Pond Center held fifty eight programs which drew 2,882 attendees.

The Widlund Art Gallery offered the opportunity for guests to view ten different shows exhibiting the artwork of numerous local and regional artists in a variety of media including an exciting taxidermy exhibit. The Johnsborg Central School student art exhibit drew a constant flow of people from the local community and the amazing Daring Descents exhibit proudly showcased the enjoyment of winter sports in our region.

The Performance committee scheduled seventeen programs and audiences enjoyed a variety of music genres as well as comedy, dance, and theater productions in the 2023 season. The popular Winter Coffeehouse and Summer Concert Series programming returned in the Lyle Dye Auditorium for a second year, and the annual performances of the Lake Placid Sinfonietta and North Country Jazz Project filled the house.

The Events committee focused on community programs and hosted thirty one events including workshops, Kids Art, an Ice cream social and community day. The Outdoor show was a huge success drawing over 1,000 people from around the region. Best of the Best returned giving students from three school districts, the opportunity to showcase scenes from their school plays. The first time showing of the Warren Miller movies was another success and Tannery Pond plans to make this an annual event. Our second ice cream social on the front steps of Tannery Pond delighted passersby.

Tannery Pond Center enjoyed participation in the town-wide events including the July 4th and Holiday parades; a Kids Art booth at the July 4th Ski Bowl family day; and the annual Johnsborg Tree lighting and reception, which was held at Tannery Pond Community Center this year.

We have also turned our efforts towards building enhancements to provide a beautiful and welcoming venue for visitors. Visit the community kiosk now available on the exterior of the building and enjoy our café seating area in the Widlund Gallery.

We were so lucky to have several very generous donors this year. We had a \$25,000 match that we met and surpassed. A big thank you to all our 2023 donors and especially those who donate every year and continually throughout the year in response to our appeals. Grants and ticket revenue only get us so far with programming costs, so your dollars support not only the events, but the needed infrastructure necessary for continuous programming. Tannery Pond Center is so very appreciative of your support.


